




Galway Today




















Changing the face of cancer treatment.




Lily: Preventing hair loss, the biggest fear for patients.

Lily will be FDA cleared in Q2 2025 with reimbursement codes already in place - enabling better quality cancer care immediately.


































"By prioritizing understanding and withholding bias, we naturally cultivate empathy and compassion towards those affected by the problem. This empathetic approach enables us to connect on a deeper level with stakeholders, grasp their needs and concerns, and tailor solutions that address their unique circumstances"

"The majority of our modules have been taught through a passive teaching approach, including lectures and online recordings. This module challenged those traditional forms of learning and allowed us to expand our learning capabilities by pushing us outside of our comfort zones.  'SUPERHUMAN', at the Galway City Museum.






